



PHASE 3 GUIDELINES: To begin Monday July 13, 2020

If you are not feeling well for ANY reason, please stay home.

If you have **tested positive for COVID-19**, **or been exposed** to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 and are required to self-isolate, **you must isolate at your permanent residence.**

Always keep at least a 6-foot distance between you and others. Visitors of the same **household** are not required to social distance from each other.

If you cannot maintain a distance of SIX FEET from someone outside your household, YES YOU NEED TO WEAR A MASK AND YES EVEN OUTSIDE. ALWAYS carry your mask with you. If a situation arises you can put it on. PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN ON THIS RULE AND PLEASE SUPERVISE YOUNG CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES. WE ARE ALL COUNTING ON YOU.

Gatherings must be limited to ten people, this includes campsites. Follow social distancing and face covering guidelines if they are not members of your household.

All campsite units must be **SELF CONTAINED** Recreational vehicles, trailers, and motor homes (units with holding tanks, bathroom, shower, and cooking facilities).

Occupancy of Self-Contained Units is limited to a maximum of **8 occupants of the same household per campsite**.

DAY VISITORS/GUESTS are allowed on a trial basis. No overnight visitors will be welcomed until further notice. Each site is limited to 1 family unit per day. All visitors must check in and out at the store window to provide an address and phone/email for contact tracing purposes.

CHECK IN is 10:00AM and CHECK OUT is 8:00PM. Failure to comply with our visitor guidelines will restrict future visitor privileges.

Parents or Guardians MUST be in proximity of your children AT ALL TIMES at the playground and beach/pond areas.

If you need to make a payment (electric bill, seasonal payment, honey wagons, store items etc.) please either call us with a credit-card or place your check/cash payments in our grey drop box outside the store.

Some campground sponsored activities are suspended until further notice.

Golf carts are allowed provided that social distancing and face covering guidelines are followed, and you DO NOT give rides to people other than members of your own household.

Fishing, biking, and walking are allowed provided that social distancing and face covering guidelines are followed.

Out of state visitors traveling into MA are urged to self-quarantine for 14 days unless you are from Rhode Island, Connecticut, Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine, New York and New Jersey.

List of services & amenities that are currently OPEN

- Laundry Room– 1 family at a time BY APPOINTMENT ONLY call for day/time Mon-Fri: 9:00AM-5:00PM
 2 hour blocks per family
- Store (limited hours) is window service only. You MUST wear a mask when using the window. Mon-Fri: 1:00PM-5:00PM Sat-Sun: 9:00AM-5:00PM

**We will be available for EMERGENCIES ONLY outside of these hours

- Fishing- DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY
 - MUST following social distancing guidelines and wear a face mask or covering
- Honey Wagons- BY APPOINTMENT ONLY-call for day/time
 - Tue-Fri: 9:00AM-1:00PM Sat-Sun: 9:00AM-3:00PM

**Reminder- you MUST be at your site to get a honey wagon

- **Beach/Pond Area** OPEN only if we can maintain social distancing Campsites must maintain 12 feet between each other
- Playground Area Open everyday ONLY if social distancing and face covering guidelines are followed Everyone over the age of 2 must wear a mask at all times while in the playground area **Disinfected daily**
