Effective June 12, 2020 / Updated June 10, 2020

Massachusetts is moving into phase 2 and the guidelines are strict for campgrounds. Please know that many of our amenities will not be available as normal. Phase 2 is designed with restrictions that maximize physical distance with others. On a positive note, Phase 3 looks less restrictive and may be as early as June 29th.

Please remember, if an amenity or building is not open, or an activity is not happening it is either not allowed, or because we cannot do so without compromising social distancing protocols.

Hopefully, below will address some of your frequently asked questions. Please feel free to reach out to us if you have any other questions or concerns.

Phase 2 will start on Friday June 12, 2020

GATHERINGS MUST BE LIMITED TO TEN PEOPLE, THIS INCLUDES CAMPSITES. Follow social distancing and face covering guidelines if they are not members of your household.

Face Coverings:

If you cannot maintain a distance of SIX FEET from someone outside your household, YES YOU NEED TO WEAR A MASK AND YES EVEN OUTSIDE. ALWAYS carry your mask with you. If a situation arises you can put it on. PLEASE INSTRUCT YOUR CHILDREN ON THIS RULE AND PLEASE SUPERVISE YOUNG CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES. WE ARE ALL COUNTING ON YOU!!

Restrooms:

Our main and only restroom will be closed in Phase 2. Unfortunately, we cannot meet the social distancing requirements the state is demanding.

Tent/Pop-Up Camping and Nightly Camping:

Due to the many restrictions the state has imposed on Campgrounds and the inability to provide adequate bathroom facilities, we will not be able to accommodate any tents or pop-ups in Phase 2. We are also NOT accepting reservations for nightly campers until at least Phase 3.

Pond/ Beach:

Phase 2 allows for beaches to be open but with social distancing. If we can have everyone's cooperation, we will continue to keep the pond/beach open. Fishing is allowed, remember to follow social distancing and face covering guidelines. Campsite groups cannot exceed 10 people and you MUST wear a mask if you cannot maintain social distance. Masks are not necessary in the water.

Visitors:

The guidelines are clear in Phase 2, **no additional guests outside of your household**. Put all members of your household on your seasonal agreement if you would like them to visit with you. Normal occupancy restrictions apply, please see our rules. In addition, continue to observe the state mandated rule of no more than 10 people in a gathering on or off your campsite. Please help us by informing your circle of friends and family, and by registering your entire household on your agreement (\$50 for each child under 18, \$150 for 18+) OR wait until this restriction to be lifted on or around June 29th.

Activities and Entertainment:

Unfortunately, we are not allowed to return to our planned entertainment, nor host any organized events during Phase 2. We are becoming very inventive with some socially distanced activities, such as ‘Virtual Scavenger Hunts, Golf Cart Parades and Grab and Go Activity Kits’. We are very hopeful this will change in Phase 3, which could start as early as June 29th.

Playground:

Playground will not be open. Unfortunately, we cannot meet the social distancing and disinfecting requirements the state is demanding.

Laundry Room:

Laundry Room will remain closed in Phase 2. Unfortunately, we cannot meet the social distancing requirements the state is demanding. There is a Laundromat down the street in Sturbridge.

Camp Store:

The restrictions in Phase 2 make it too difficult to open our store. We will continue to conduct business through our “Service Window.” **You must wear a mask when using our walk-up window.** No exceptions.

These restrictions are non-negotiable. If you cannot agree to these, then we would prefer that you postpone your stay with us. Please do not feel forced to camp if you cannot agree to these conditions, or if you do not feel safe.

In closing, thank you for your understanding and cooperation in these strange times. We appreciate all the love and support you have shown us during this difficult time.
